A part-time Technician is required to support our Technologies and Art Departments by providing high quality technical support two and a half days per week within the departments.

The role will mainly support Resistant Materials, though some flexibility will be required to work across other curriculum areas and departments as necessary. Duties will include, but are not limited to, safety and maintenance checks on all the machines in the workshop, preparation of materials and resources for lessons as required (some of which would require using CAD/CAM software, including using the laser cutter and 3D printer), ordering of materials, setting out equipment and assistance in the daily management of equipment and tools and their general repairs.

The successful candidate should have experience of working in a similar role, ideally within an educational setting. It is essential that the successful candidate has excellent organisational skills, works well both independently and as part of a team, is able to follow instructions and shows initiative. The post holder will need to develop effective and safe in class practices, and will be expected to work in a classroom situation to support practical lessons.
